To be eligible for this award you must qualify on the following:

- Canadian or permanent resident;
- Academic achievement (minimum of 2.0 GPA on the most recent Fall/Spring terms over a minimum of 24.0 credit hours);
- Current involvement in innovative development activities or entrepreneurship (i.e. Alberta Innovates, Enactus or self-directed business).
- Have NOT received this award in previous years

This award valued at \$1,500 is payable upon confirmation of full-time enrollment at the University of Lethbridge in the Spring semester immediately following the granting of the award. Selection will be made by committee. The factors that will be taken into consideration include: the candidate's academic standing, the application content and description of the activities or proposal (including plans for continued engagement), and the innovativeness of the approach in the proposal.

The one-page document must include:

- [1] The title
- [2] The support team (if applicable)
- [3] The opportunity or problem
- [4] The business idea or proposed solution
- [5] How the solution will be implemented / translated

All candidates MUST adhere to the application format. Applications will be rejected for lack of compliance. No exceptions.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD:

- Unless otherwise stated (refer to part 15 of the Calendar), to be eligible for awards administered by the University of Lethbridge, applicants must maintain continuous, full-time status at the University of Lethbridge during the academic year the award was issued.
- Normally, awards are payable only at the University of Lethbridge and only for the stated academic year.
- According to Canadian tax regulations, the University of Lethbridge is required to issue T4A slips to award recipients. Therefore; students must provide their Social Insurance Number in order to receive an award (unless attending on an international student visa).
